IO2 Germany Today: political, economic, cultural and historic aspects

In the second part, we will look at the economy with a special focus on small and mediumsized enterprises (SME) and "Hidden Champions". Accounting for more than 99% of all companies, SME form the backbone of the German economy and are also characterized by their high share of industrial production.
