#### Are there orientation days for incoming exchange students?

About 10 days before the lectures start. During this time we offer a German crash-course for interested students.

Shared flats; monthly rate from 300€ to 325€

#### Money?

No tuition fee, but 155,-€ for the students union You will need 850,-€ per month as a minimum.

#### **Transportation?**

With the semesterticket (€ 185.-) you can use all trams, busses and trains (except ICE, EC) in a radius of 50 km for 6 months.
